During this time, Mr. Mullaney developed and updated database programs for the purposes of tracking the storage and use of over 1500 hazardous chemicals on the Army installation and for meeting other State and Federal Environmental compliance requirements.

Mr. Mullaney is a highly motivated and proficient professional who is skilled in accomplishing all assigned responsibilities. He has the ability to work effectively with personnel at all levels, analyze their work requirements, and translate these requirements into appropriate software support. Regardless of whether it is a challenging area of responsibility or a minor duty such as assisting staff in using a modem, Mr. Mullaney proceeds with a "can do" attitude. Our staff has appreciated his positive approach in meeting unexpected challenges and resolving problems.

Although Mr. Mullaney does not have a background in environmental science, he quickly demonstrated outstanding analytical abilities in defining problems and developing solutions.
